Fraser Figure Skating Club Fundraising Requirements & Policy

Each first club skater is required to raise \$350.00 (\$450 per family) for the club this season. The skater may raise more than is required. Initiation first year members are required to raise \$150 in their initiation season.

A second club member and additional family members (which their home club is NOT Fraser FSC) are required to raise \$150 for the club each season. The skater may raise more than is required.

Honorary Members, adults, and collegiate members are exempt from fundraising.

*** Half the fundraising obligation is required to be filled by Jan 31, 2024. ***

Skater's Signature (if over 18)

If the skater does not raise the required amount for their membership type for the season (July 1, 2023 – June 30, 2024) they will be required to pay the difference.

25% of the money raised beyond the skater or family's fundraising requirement will go towards the skater's account. The maximum amount allowed towards the skater's bill is \$599.00. **This is not negotiable.**

We will be hosting numerous events and opportunities throughout the season to fundraise.
