Mandatory Worker Assignments:

- It is **mandatory** to volunteer to work at least one show and one rehearsal (you do not need a ticket for the shows you volunteer to work)
- We will send out a sign-up genius for volunteer positions needed
- All volunteers should arrive one hour before each performance/rehearsal

Publicity:

Please help publicize our show by placing ads in newspapers, posting on social media, distributing flyers to stores, schools, businesses and other organizations. If you know of anyone via the news within the local community or outside networks (Channel 7, Channel 4, etc), please see if they can come out to publicize our event.

Costumes:

You will be notified via email when your costumes have arrived for pick-up. Please have your skater try on their costumes right away. Report costume issues immediately to Chris Wojno at 586.764.3811 or ffscspringtimeoniceshow@gmail.com.

Tights:

Please purchase Mondor suntan footed tights (3310) for the show. Two pairs are recommended in the event of holes or stains.

Body Suits:

For learn to skate participants age ten and under with a costume change, a skin-colored body suit is required.

NO PARENTS/GUARDIANS/FAMILY/FRIENDS WILL BE ALLOWED IN THE LOCKER ROOM UNLESS YOU ARE SAFESKATE COMPLIANT AND VOLUNTEERING FOR THE SHOW!



All skaters must have their own clean white skates and clean laces for each performance, skate guards with their name clearly marked on them, and a long robe/jacket/sweater to wear over costume.

Group Pictures for Ice Show Program:

Picture day is scheduled for April 15. Picture day schedule and order form are attached. Skaters are to wear their ice show costume and have hair done according to costume instructions for pictures. There will also be an opportunity for you to have your skater's individual photo taken as well. All FFSC Club skaters will take a group photo- please wear a nice competition dress and have hair neatly pulled away from your face. Any updates will be sent via email.

Video Taping:

A videographer will film the Saturday night performance. DVDs will be available for purchase. The cost per video is \$20.

Attendance at Practices:

Practices are mandatory and attendance will be taken at all practices. Absences can result in loss of ice show privileges. Please communicate with Chris and your assigned choreographer if you need to arrange for an excused absence.

Fundraising:

We will once again be raffling off a Yeti cooler full of cheer. Raised funds are used to help pay for the cost of ice and lighting rental for the weekend. Please make every effort to promote the raffle.

VERY IMPORTANT!!!! LOCKER ROOM PARENTS MUST BE SAFESKATE CERTIFIED. PARENTS WHO SIGN UP TO VOLUNTEER IN ANY OF THE LOCKER ROOMS CANNOT LEAVE THE SKATERS UNATTENDED. YOU ARE RESPONSIBLE FOR THESE CHILDREN. PLEASE ESCORT THEM TO THE RESTROOM, ETC. AT THE END OF THE SHOW, YOU MUST RELEASE TO THEIR PARENT/GUARDIAN. IF YOU HAVE A SKATER THAT IS NOT PICKED UP, PLEASE INFORM US AT THE VOLUNTEER TABLE AND YOU MAY LEAVE THEM WITH US. DO NOT LEAVE YOUR ROOM UNTIL ALL SKATERS HAVE BEEN RELEASED TO A PARENT!!



Please take the time to read this packet as this has a lot of information in regards to the show. Thank you for having your skater join us and participate in our show. It takes all of you to make this show a success. A few items to remember:

- Try on costume as soon as you receive it. If there is any problem, please contact Chris.
- Hang your costume to prevent wrinkles. Make sure to put your skaters name on all pieces. Your costume may require some minor sewing.
- **Purchase Mondor Suntan footed tights (not over the boot).** You may want to purchase 2 pairs in case they ruin a pair.
- Skater's hair must be up and away from face. Skaters, if hair length allows, should wear secure buns with hair nets. **Bobby pins are not allowed.**
- Make-up should be applied so it will show from the audience (for dress rehearsal & shows). Theatrical use of Bronzer, heavy blush, dark eyeshadow and bright red lipstick should be used. Other colors washout in the spotlights.
- No jewelry, unless it comes with the costume.
- Clean skates and laces (no rental skates).
- NO UNDERWEAR or other visible undergarments.
- Have skate guards All skaters must have guards with their names/initials on them.
- Have a robe or cover-up.
- Basic Skill Skaters arrive in costume with skates on.
- Skaters will be assigned a locker room. Skaters will be with their chaperone during the show. SKATERS ARE NOT ALLOWED TO SIT WITH PARENTS DURING SHOW.
- Skater & Volunteers must arrive one (1) hour before the show. Please drop skater off at check-in table. They will stay with chaperone until parents pick them up after show.
- No skater will be released without a parent. Skaters will not be allowed out of the building into the parking lot. This means parents must come into the building to the volunteer table to pick up your skater. This applies to all shows and rehearsals. This is for the safety of your child.
- **Bring a snack.** Skaters are not allowed to pass by the volunteer table to go to snack bar during rehearsals and shows. Bring something to eat and drink. We will have a snack table set up for the skaters during the performances. We would greatly appreciate donations of snacks and bottles of water. Clear drinks and individually wrapped finger foods are the best choice.


