





## **Registration**

Fall/Winter/Spring Ice Registration Due: September 1st, 2023

Please drop off in the office, email, or mail your ice registration with the deposit <u>by the September 1st due date</u>. You may drop your contracts in the club mailbox at the club office in Big Boy Arena at any other time. We must receive the contract on the day you start your contract ice. **A \$25 late fee will apply for any payments received after September 6**<sup>th</sup>.

Reminder: To contract club ice you must be current USFS member with a <u>PAID IN FULL</u> membership in good standing. This includes closeout of summer ice financial obligations.



#### **Payments and Policies**

#### MEMBERSHIP MUST BE PAID IN FULL TO CONTRACT ICE

Contract can be paid in full. All contracts over \$2,000 paid in full will receive a 5% Discount.

#### Payment Plan is broken up into 9 payments.

- 1. 20% Deposit September 2<sup>nd</sup>, 2022
- 2. 10% October 1<sup>st</sup>, 2023
- 3. 10% November 1<sup>st</sup>, 2023
- 4. 10% December 1st, 2023 (Must be paid to date to participate in holiday show)
- 5. 10% January 3<sup>rd</sup>, 2024
- 6. 10% February 1st, 2024
- 7. 10% March 1st, 2024
- 8. 10% April 1st, 2024
- 9. 10% May 1<sup>st</sup>, 2024 (Must be paid to date to participate in spring show)

#### NO REFUNDS FOR ANY REASON – You are responsible for your contract

- \*FFSC reserves the right to dismiss, without refund, anyone who refuses to obey rules by club or arena.
- \*25.00 fee assessed for any returned checks
- \*\$25.00 fee assessed for late payments 5-day grace period will apply
- \*Suspension of ice privileges and club privileges for late accounts over two months in arrears.
- \*After injury requiring medical attention; skater must have doctor's written permission to return to ice.

#### **Test Sessions**

A full panel in person test session will be on Friday, January 5<sup>th</sup> in coordination with MidAmerica.

We will be moving towards a primarily virtual test format. Virtual test sessions will be offered every other month. Virtual test policy is forthcoming. Lower-level single judge panel skating skills and singles in-person tests can be arranged through the skating director on an as needed basis.

Test applications can be found on our website and outside the club office. Your coach must approve and sign your Test application.

## **Off-ice Training**

Off-ice training will be offered throughout the year. In addition to being cost effective, off-ice training provides direct results to progress on the ice. Off-ice training will be instructor lead in a group setting. All levels of Aspire and club skaters are encouraged to supplement their training with off-ice sessions.

## **Holiday Extravaganza**

Our holiday show will be held December 10th, 2023 in the Priority (1) rink. Registration will be available in November. In addition to solos and small groups, a production number for club members will be offered.

## **Springtime on Ice Show**

Springtime on Ice show is scheduled for May 10 & 11, 2024 in Priority (1) rink. We will be sending out show sign-up packets at the beginning of the new year. To qualify for a solo, you must contract at least a total of four on-ice sessions. To qualify for a feature, you must contract at least a total of three sessions (an off-ice session will count as one session for features).

## **Coaching Staff**

We have a very diverse coaching staff at Fraser. All FFSC staff coaches can teach all levels on all our sessions. Learn to Skate coaching staff can teach introductory levels on identified sessions.

**General Qualifications**: Fraser Figure Skating Club members may contract ice.

#### DROP-IN - Skaters must sign in and fees must be paid before entering the ice

**Members -** \$20 per general session for contracted skaters, \$22 per general session for non-contracted skaters. Off-Ice \$12 per session, \$25 drop in at the gym.

**Junior Club** - \$14 for 25 or 30 minutes of a session. The skater must be with their coach their lesson. Once the lesson is over, the skater must leave the ice. Must have a current Aspire or Learn to Skate Membership

**Hockey skaters** - \$17 for 25 or 30 minutes of a session. The skater must be with their coach the entire lesson. Once the lesson is over, the skater must leave the ice. Sticks are NOT allowed. Must have a current USA Hockey or Learn to Skate Membership.

**Vouchers** - To make up for cancelled sessions, vouchers will be issued by the Director only. Vouchers are only redeemable for ice sessions and have no cash value. Vouchers must be redeemed before the end of the contract. The vouchers are only good for the person on the voucher; no gifting vouchers is allowed.
